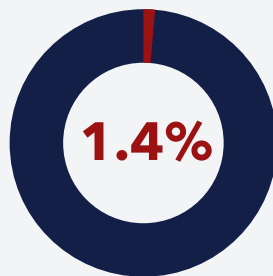


The Women & Girls Philanthropy Index of Massachusetts (WGIMA) is the only comprehensive index to measure charitable giving to women and girls-serving nonprofit organizations (WSO/GSO) in Massachusetts. This WGIMA, which represents 2022 giving data, is a report created by the Women's Foundation of Boston to track and understand the philanthropic support received by WSO/GSO's across the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The results underscore the continued massive underinvestment in women and girls.

2022 CHARITABLE GIVING ACROSS MASSACHUSETTS

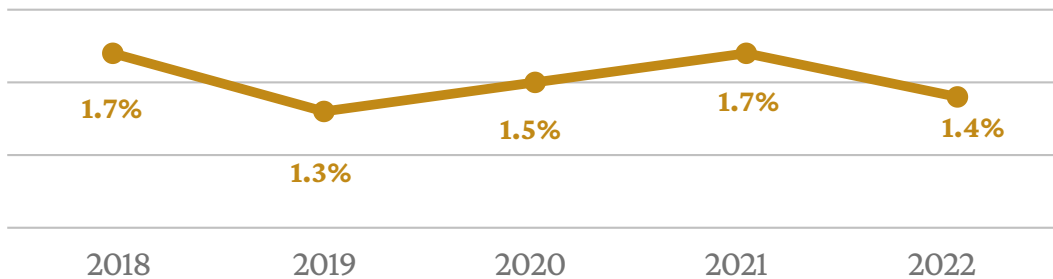
Philanthropic support for WSO/GSO totaled \$673 million in 2022, **dropping to 1.4% of overall charitable giving** in Massachusetts, below the national average of 1.8%.

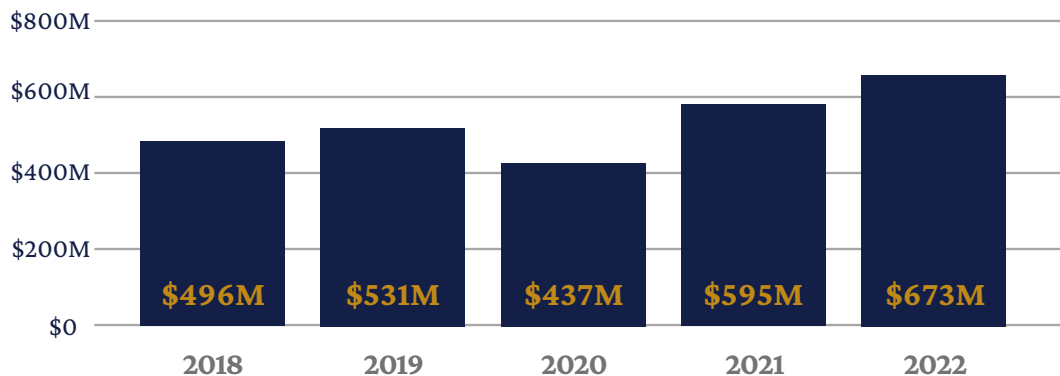

The index also highlights that with its exponential growth, in 2022, the **Women's Foundation of Boston is ranked as the 19th largest women- and girls-serving organization** in Massachusetts, up from 47th in 2021.
